



## Teen Leadership Program Description

Any teen between the ages of 13 and 17 living in San Francisco may apply to the program. Program participants can earn up to **\$800** in stipends.

Telegraph Hill Neighborhood Center's (Tel-Hi) Teen Leadership Program is a year-round life skills and job development program. The Teen Leadership Program aims to foster the positive development of teens by providing meaningful and challenging experiences to increase career and educational awareness, job skills development, leadership, and their appreciation for community involvement/engagement. Throughout the year, teens will participate in team building activities, life skill workshops, and job development. Teens will also have the opportunity to contribute to their community through engaging service projects and partaking in fun innovative enrichment activities throughout San Francisco and the Bay Area. Sample activities could include local college and university visits, participation in the Lunar New Years Parade as well as other annual city events, and attending sports and cultural events. The teens will support Tel-Hi's various programs, including Preschool (ages 2 1/2-5), Elementary (grades K-5th), and Seniors Program (ages 65+), to utilize the skills gained from workshops and enrichment activities.
